**1) Please prepare a short monologue titled "ME". This will be a monologue you will present to the class.**

~~ Your monologue should include your full name, birthday, where you live, the name of your school, and anything else you feel is notable. ("My eyes are 2 different colors") Next, briefly tell us about something BIG that has happened to you, OR something you really love (and why) or really dislike (and why)!

~~The next part of your monologue should start, " I have been a student at the Children's Theatre for \_\_\_\_\_ years." (Or tell us if you're new!) Then tell us about your favorite parts of Theatre, and what you think you're best at. Finally, talk about what you hope to learn this year in our class.

~~Practice saying this monologue out loud a few times before next class.

~~I will be collecting and making a copy of your monologue, so make sure I can read it! If you are using your computer, please print in black ink only.

**2) For next week, bring the following to class:**

\*1" or 1 1/2" ring binder (put your name on it!) Recycled is just fine.

\*Sharpened pencil or two
